

JA Zenchu's Position on Japan-Canada EPA Negotiations

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Conclusion at the last symposium in November, 2012, Tokyo

- <u>Canada</u> is the 4th agricultural exporter to Japan and thus is <u>responsible for</u> <u>food security in Japan</u>. Its responsibility should be taken in ways to <u>ensure</u> <u>predictable and stable supply of food</u> that Japanese people demand as well as to <u>not undermine sustainable development of agriculture in Japan</u>.
- Farmers in Japan and Canada have mutually cooperated so far in terms of both policy making and businesses. Japan-Canada EPA negotiations must not undermine such a partnership, but should rather promote strengthening relationship of farmers in both countries.
- For bilateral and pluri-lateral negotiations, Japan should seek qualified negotiating partners that respect awareness of food security among Japanese people. Regarding the Japan-Canada EPA negotiations launched in November, 2012, the Report of the Joint Study should be fully respected in the official negotiations, particularly with respect of market access of agriculture, forestry and fishery products as well as export prohibitions and restrictions;

[Market Access]


- Canada and Japan concurred that sufficient attention should be given to the importance of striking a balance between the facilitation of trade in agricultural, forestry and fishery products, and the sound development of domestic agriculture, forestry, fisheries and rural areas.
- In this regard, the two countries shared the mutual understanding that practical and flexible approaches should be taken with respect to sensitivities in agriculture, forestry and fishery products in the negotiations of a possible EPA between Canada and Japan.

[Others (Energy, Minerals and Foods)]


- Noting that global demands for energy, minerals and foods continue to increase, Canada and Japan recognized that 'energy security' and 'food security' remain a priority issue globally.
- The two countries reaffirmed their obligation to comply with the relevant provisions of the WTO Agreement, including the GATT 1994, with respect to prohibitions or restrictions on the exportation of energy, mineral resources and food goods.

Our Challenge amid Aging of Farmers with Less Access of Youth Entering into Agriculture


- In order for efficient use of farmlands and improvement of farmers' income, JA Zenchu promotes to identify "Active Farmers" who take leadership role in agricultural production activities at the local level with a farmland size of 20-30 ha. (currently, average size of farmland in Japan is 2.3ha/household.)
- Promotion and facilitation of such structural reform by the JAs (cooperatives) will help to concentrate small and separated farmlands smoothly to "Active Farmers" in transition periods.



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

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Trends in Feed Grains and Meat Prices






These are all EPAs which Japan concluded so far.



Average Planted Area per Farm Household



- Production scale per a farm household or a group of farmers is expanding steadily. Volume of production is also increasing accordingly.
- Domestic wheat production is <u>essential for sustainable crop rotation. At</u> <u>the same time, it is a strategic product to improve domestic self-</u> <u>sufficiency.</u>
- Wheat is entirely <u>excluded from tariff elimination under any EPA agreed</u> <u>by Japan so far</u>.



Soybean Domestic Production: 219,000 t (2011)

- Like wheat, domestic soybean production is <u>essential for sustainable crop</u> rotation. It is also <u>a strategic product to improve food self-sufficiency</u>. <u>Production scale is expanding</u> steadily, while it is already <u>duty-free for</u> <u>imports</u>.
- Japan is a large importer of oilseeds from exporting countries including Canada. The import of oilseeds is duty free, while specific tariffs are applied on some edible oils.
